Additional information

The instructions of 23.3.2020 continue to apply, and the changes that apply from 1.4.2020 are summarised below.

In principle, the following still applies: Leaving the apartment or house without a valid reason is prohibited.

Additions

You are allowed to leave the home for the following reasons:

- Ensuring the supply of basic goods to the population, including collection and delivery services (also in the context of voluntary work)
- Performing necessary deliveries, including mail and mail order business
- Visiting spouses, life partners and cohabiting partners, people in need of help, sick people or people with disabilities (outside institutions) and exercising the right of care and access in their respective private spheres.
- Accompanying persons in need of support including minors
- Accompanying the dying as well as attending funerals of immediate family members, whereby the number of persons must not exceed 15

It is prohibited to visit old people's and nursing facilities and outpatient assisted living communities and residential groups with people with disabilities, hospitals and preventive and rehabilitation facilities.

Visits **by close relatives** to maternity wards, children's wards and palliative care wards, as well as hospices and visits to accompany dying family members are excluded from the ban. Visits must be coordinated in advance with the management of the respective facilities.

Sports activities in all public and private sports facilities (both outdoor and indoor) are prohibited.

Meetings in churches, mosques, synagogues and other religious communities are also prohibited, as are meetings in clubs and other sports and leisure facilities.

Anyone found on the street during checks by the regulatory authorities (police, public order office) must state the reasons why they are away from home. This can be done by presenting a **work certificate**, a company or service card or by presenting personal documents.

The two infringements stated below and their respective monetary penalties are being strictly enforced:

- Leaving home without good reason
Fine: 150 Euro
- Breaching visiting ban
Fine (for visitors): 500 Euro

These regulations apply from 1.4.2020 until 20.4.2020
